

WHAT TO BRING ON YOUR 1st DAY OF CLASS

Reminder: Please email or bring proof of shots to the first day of class. No shots/no entry. (Puppies under 6 months excluded)

Any dog that is uncontrollable, very fearful or showing aggressive behaviors will be not be permitted in class. We are here to discuss the issues at hand and available for Private instruction.

Bring a hungry dog, (but not starving) as we use food reward training methods. Depending on the time of your class, feed your dog ½ his breakfast/dinner and bring the rest of his kibble mixed with **small, soft, smelly** treats, also bring some high value food cheese, ham, chicken or hotdogs. Make sure you cut the treats into small bites before the class. No dry cookies please. Training treats available for purchase - \$5/bag.

Please put your food treats in a treat bag or clothing with loose pockets for easy access. Timing is everything! Please purchase one prior to class, **Plastic bags will not be accepted as treat bags.**

Please bring your dog's favorite chew toy for the times in class when he needs to settle and lie down quietly (i.e. Kong stuffed with cream cheese or peanut butter). You should also bring bully sticks or something you can hold while your dog chews it.

- Please exercise your dog or do for a walk before class.
- Please bring a non-squeaky tug toy
- Bring a non-skid mat or towel for your dog to lie on.
- Bring poop bags.
- Bring a secure fitting collar and a 6 foot nylon or leather leash. Collars and leashes are available for purchase \$10 each.

Wear weather-appropriate clothing as our training sessions can be outdoors. We recommend you wear sneakers or closed toe shoes.

Please check our Facebook page for cancellations due to weather. Rainwind-hail or snow or extreme heat.

Please do not allow your dog to mob the dogs entering the building/ training area. Give the entering dogs space so they can get used to the new environment.

Do not bring your dog if you think he is sick.

One handler per dog. Well, behaved children over the age of 10 are welcome and all family members are encouraged to observe.

Please check event calendar for class location.
